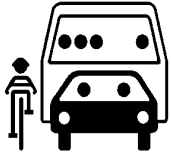

Re: FY 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program Administrative Amendments

Background

WATS completes administrative amendments as needed for the FY 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and provides them as information items to the Committees along with full amendments. Administrative amendments are minor changes made on TIP projects without going through the committee process. WATS may amend modifications such as cost decreases, slight cost increases, small changes in limits or a change in the implementing agency, etc, without Committee approval. WATS and SEMCOG use administrative amendments to expedite the processing of small changes without delaying a project.
