

WHAT'S A SHARROW?

Sharrows are used to guide bicyclists on streets that don't have bike lanes. They're a simple reminder to car drivers and bicyclists to **share the road!**

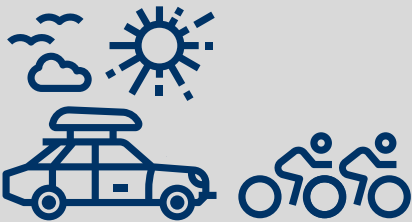


When you see **sharrows** on the road...

Expect to share the road with bikes and be ready to **slow down.**



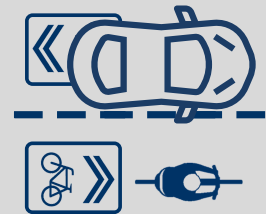

When parking is present, bicyclists will be riding in the middle of the lane to **avoid the door zone.**

MI law requires at least 3 feet of **space when passing** bicyclists. Change lanes to pass if necessary!



Safety Tips for Bicyclists:

Use caution and hand signals when stopping and making turns, always ride with a light or reflector when it is dark, and obey all traffic laws.
